Due to the rapid escalation of local COVID-19 numbers and the current COVID-19 health status being in the severe category, the City of San Antonio has made the difficult decision to cancel all scheduled events for January 2021 due to take place at the Alamodome, Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center, Lila Cockrell Theatre and the Carver Community Cultural Center.

The current Mayor's Emergency Declaration and Bexar County Executive Order and the recent determination by the State of Texas that we are in a "high hospitalization" area provide grounds for termination under Section 15.1(b) of our License Agreement. The health and safety of our patrons is our utmost concern and the City is committed to slowing the spread of COVID-19 during this significant surge in infections and hospitalizations.

As we continue to evaluate the scheduling of current and future events, health and safety remain our priorities and we will follow the guidance and recommendations of local, regional and global health officials and organizations. With that in mind, we hope to be able to reschedule your event for a future date. In the meantime, we will process the deposit you provided for refund under the terms of the Agreement.
